Number of players: 5 and above. How is it played?

In the beginning, all players should stand in a semi-circle. After that, one player should stand in front of them in order to throw the ball away.

Fishing net

Fishing net is a net used to catch fish.



It is made from fibers woven in a net structure. It contains from 300 to 3700 meshes. The threads are knotted by using a big needle.

Lead is also added to the edges of the net to make it heavier.





After the Fishing net spreads out on the water and sinks, the fisher dives to the bottom and collects it. It can also be tied to a fishing line. Once it catches any fish it gets pulled out by hand.
