



HE Yousuf bin Alawi Launches Oman E-Visa



Oman Police Royal launched on Monday 19 / 6 / 2017 the e-visa service under the auspices of His Excellency Yousuf bin Alawi bin Abdullah, Minister responsible for Foreign Affairs. The launching ceremony was held at the Special Taskforce Police Command in Asseeb, and attended by His Excellency Lt Gen Hassan bin Muhsin Al Shuraigi, Inspector General of Police and Customs, ministers, undersecretaries, senior police, armed forces and security officers as well as dignitaries. The ceremony began with a footage showing how to apply and how to get Oman eVisa.

His Excellency Yousuf Bin Alawi commended the e-visa service and said "It's a big achievement we are proud of. The system ensures the privacy of the visitors' details, and provides easy access to visitors including tourists, businesspersons and students. It's an outcome of the country's stability and constant development. It will open wide horizons for the electronic transformation in the future." He added



that Oman was achieving a leap in modern technology as a result of His Majesty the Sultan's concern for providing easy life for the citizens and residents alike.

His Excellency Ahmed bin Nasser Al Mahrazi, Minister of Tourism said that the e-visa is a qualitative development in the process of getting entry visa easily and immediately. He indicated that the tourism sector in Oman had developed beyond the plans. Three million tourists visited Oman last year, and the number is expected to leap to 4.7m by 2020, he added.

He added that this big growth in the tourism sector needed to be supported with easy obtainable visa to open Oman for more tourism exporting countries like China, Russia and the USA.

The e-visa service is linked through an integral system with some relevant ministries like the Ministry of Manpower regarding labour permits, the Ministry of Commerce and Industry regarding the validity of the commercial registration, and the Ministry of Civil Service regarding the government departments visas. Now applicants can apply for, pay the fees and get the visa online, and will no longer need to physically visit the visa counters and do paperwork.

The system is in accordance with the requirements of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the International Tourism Organization with regard to the travelers traffic.



Police Special Taskforce Unit Opened in Nizwa

On March29, 2017 a police taskforce unit was opened and new batches of police recruits passed out in Nizwa, Addakhiliya Governorate.

The opening ceremony was held under the auspices of His Excellency Mohammed bin Salem Attoubi, Minister of Environment and Climate Affairs, and attended by His Excellency Lt Gen Hassan bin Muhsin Al-Shuraiqi, Inspector General of Police and Customs and dignitaries.

New ROP Systems Shown in Comex 2017




