



Two New Border Posts in Al Buraimi

Within the strategy to expand and enhance the border services,

Royal Oman Police opened recently two border posts, Hamasa and Saara', in Al Buraimi. The Hamasa border post was opened on 30/5/2018 in a ceremony presided over by His Excellency Khalid bin Hilal Al Busaidi, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Interior, and attended by Maj Gen Hamad bin Sulaiman Al Hatmi, Assist. Inspector General of Police and Customs for Operations, dignitaries, senior police, army and security officers, sheikhs and local citizens.

The chief guest unveiled the commemorative plaque, then he, Maj Gen Hamad and guests toured the station building, which includes administrative offices, passports counters and customs yard.

On 15/5/2018 Saara' border station was opened by His Excellency Dr Said bin Khamees Al Ka'bi, President of the Public Authority for Consumer Protection in a ceremony attended by Maj Gen Hamad Al Hatmi, dignitaries, senior police, army and security officers, sheikhs and local citizens.
